The Prairie Description:

The Prairie Recovery Center is a 30-bed co-gender residential substance abuse treatment facility located in Round Top, TX that specializes in co-occurring mental health issues. The Prairie Recovery Center treats a variety of special populations including professionals, veterans, and first responders. Nestled in 46+ acres of lush green fields in Round Top—a mere 90 minutes away from Houston, Austin and San Antonio—The Prairie Recovery Center is a peaceful, countryside destination with a late 1800's farmhouse serving as the heart of the expansive facility. Position Summary:

The full time Primary Staff Therapist at PRC is part of the clinical team that creates the space and container to facilitate the healing and wellness of clients who admit to treat their substance use disorder. As the Primary Staff Therapist, the clinician will provide the support and therapeutic services related to the family dynamics of SUD and its recovery and perform in a general therapeutic role with the clinical team.

Job Requirements:

- Clinician will provide individual therapy to clients admitted to PRC at least once weekly after admission.
- Clinician will introduce the clinical program at TPRC and assist the PCA and nursing team with onboarding clients to milieu based care.
- Clinician will document all sessions, groups, calls, and other communication with family, referral sources, and appropriate stakeholders in client care per TPRC and compliance guidelines.
- Clinician will work with Clinical Director on projects and programming as assigned.
- Clinician will assist with client engagement, reducing attrition, and minimizing clients leaving against staff advice.
- Clinician will participate in professional development as organized by Clinical Director or Chief Clinical Officer.
- Clinician will assist with group process and SOAR (psychoeducational) groups as assigned.
- Clinician may be asked to attend quarterly events celebrating milestones
- Clinician may be asked to attend All Staff meetings as called (potentially quarterly).
- Clinician is expected to be available for clinical stabilization on site.
- Clinician will assist other clinical staff as part of a team. Clinician will attend and participate in weekly staff meeting.
- Clinician will attend other meetings necessary for team communication and functioning.
- Submit to a background check if hired
